One of the joys of my life has been to serve Peter and Doris Wagner. We recently celebrated Peter's harvest legacy during our Starting the Year off Right Celebration. And of course, we continue to assist Doris monthly, so that she can press forward in her ministry call. With her most recent surgery, she needs a different type of van to stay mobile. Our last two ministry vans were actually given away to the Native Americans, and for some time we had planned to purchase a new van for all of our youth, widow and outreach activities. However, we will wait on that and first purchase a custom Glory of Zion ministry van that can get Doris to where she needs to be. **For a cost of \$34,000 we can purchase a specialty van that allows her to ride in on her motorized wheelchair. Cindy Jacobs feels so strongly about this that she is sharing this request with her contacts as well: *"Since Doris had her most recent surgery and had rods affixed to her legs, she no longer can safely use the family van for her transportation. A specially-equipped van can be purchased that will allow her to go straight in the van with her wheelchair. Most of the handicapped-equipped vehicles are not made for people whose leg has been fused at the knee, so a vehicle has to be specially ordered to get the right one. When I spoke to Doris about this, she didn't want to be a bother to anyone about this, but I assured her that is not the case and that we love her. The Glory of Zion ministry van being purchased and assigned to help Doris get around cost about \$34,000. Let's all chip in to be a part of Doris staying on the move!"*
