On Tuesday evening our family set out for a meeting in Jerusalem that was scheduled for Wednesday. All of our plans ended up being canceled as we were blessed with an awesome snowstorm instead. The news in Israel reported that there had not been snow like this since 1992. The roads around the Dead Sea flooded as well as one of the main freeways in Tel Aviv. The Sea of Galilee has been replenished. Thank God for pouring out in this land.

Lily's first encounter with snow just happened to be here in Jerusalem of all places. It's the most beautiful picture I've ever seen. In this weather, you would never know that there's ever tension here. It feels like the city has been covered with a blanket of peace. Highway 1 which connects Tel Aviv and Jerusalem was also shut down for the winter weather.



Even in the Midst of Darkness ... God is Pouring Out His Glory!

I want to share something that the Lord showed me on December 1st that perhaps I should have shared sooner. This was just a few days after the operation in Gaza had ended and we began to feel an extreme shift in the atmosphere around us. We began to feel the presence of heaven in a greater way than ever before. During this time we attended an event in Haifa. In the worship I felt God pouring out in our midst in a way I hadn't felt before. The next day we went to the city of Akko, which is the most Northern port of entry into Israel. We continued to have a powerful experience with the presence of God.

While in Akko, I had encounters with two very lost and dark women. One of these women was a witch and the other was into extreme New Age practices. Both women ended up questioning me about my beliefs. One of the women said that she wanted me to be empowered and asked if I

was interested in joining her in meditation. The conversation that followed opened the door for me to share the Lord with her. I asked the women how they ended up in this city and both said they moved because Akko was the strongest energy portal in Israel. Both women explained their belief that Akko is a portal because it is the most Northern gate in the country.

I saw and felt that the enemy has a huge influence in this portal but I also saw the Lord pouring out His spirit in this region. Here God showed me that everywhere the enemy is pouring that God is also pouring. ***So as you encounter warfare, know that God is also pouring into those dark places.*** Daniel and I are watching how rapidly things are changing in the US and it can be overwhelming. Know that God is also pouring out there just as the enemy is. It feels like we are walking a tight rope as a Body. It's important to fight to stay close to the Lord. We also saw that there is a heightened level of witchcraft and deception seeping into the Church Body. The Lord is showing us how important it is to choose our friends wisely.
