Hi everyone, I'm sorry we haven't had time to write in a while. Our family has been adjusting to a new sleep schedule with our son, Elijah, who is now eleven weeks old.

For any of our readers who are parents, I'm sure you have not forgotten those sleep deprived nights. That being said, the Lord has blessed us tremendously over the last few weeks and begun to set our lives on a new course.



We have felt like the Lord had us in a holding pattern over the last several months and now we are starting to reap the harvest of seeds that have been sown. Some times it feels like we try so hard to hear God or see our next step, but then when God speaks everything becomes so clear to us.

The Word Speaks Today!

Earlier this year, the Lord spoke to me and placed it on my heart to read through the Bible from cover to cover. I started reading Genesis in May and finished the last chapter of Revelation on October third. At the time, I didn't know why God asked me to do this but I began to read out of obedience. As time passed, God started speaking to me in ways I have not known before, and He began to remind me of all the times He had spoken to me in the past. I started to remember prophetic words He had given me, from years ago. Some of these words were fulfilled immediately and some only years later. As the Lord was reminding me of all these things, I began to see a pattern emerge. It was almost like someone flipped on a light switch and I began to perceive, instead of only hearing. I love having these types of experiences with the Lord because you know He is teaching you something, so he can open a new door in your future.

A Call to Africa!

As many of you know, my wife, Amber, is a prophetic dreamer and often has dreams that the Lord has her share with the Body. Several weeks ago, Amber attended a meeting here in Jerusalem and did not return home until late in the night. While she was at the meeting, I received a phone call inviting us to meet with Apostle *Emmanuel Kure*'s group here in Jerusalem and share our testimony. Amber woke up around four in the morning and I told her about the speaking engagement that was scheduled for later that afternoon. She said, "I was just having a dream that we had been asked to speak on short notice and God was downloading to me what I should say." Later that evening, we went to the hotel, without a message, believing that God would develop what He wanted us to say, even as we began to speak. That meeting ended up being the strongest session I have been privileged to speak in. After the meeting, Emmanuel

asked Amber to pray over one of the women who was present. Everything that Amber received in her dream the night before was for this lady God had her prophesy into!



Emanuel (pictured above on the left) spoke several words over us that confirmed many things we had been hearing from the Lord, personally. Before leaving the hotel, he invited us to attend his conference in Nigeria, at the end of October. We immediately felt strongly that we were to attend this meeting and have since been watching the Lord open the door for us to go. At one point, it began to look like some of the paperwork we needed was not going to arrive on time, and I began to question if we had heard the Lord clearly concerning this trip. I remember telling Amber that same morning that it felt like we had just hit a brick wall and how frustrating it was feeling like we were stuck and unable to move forward.

That very afternoon God sent a prophet to spend the night in our home. She told us word for word the conversation we had that morning and that the wall we had seen was a false wall and our path had already been laid straight on the other side! We had never met her before so there is no way she could have known about the trip to Africa or our current circumstances. As soon as Sukkot ended we received the paperwork and things began moving again.

Over the next week, we had several chance meetings with people from West Africa who continued to speak encouraging words over us. We needed to hear these words because things only got more challenging after that. I ended up running a high fever for two days from the yellow fever vaccination and had to make four trips to Tel Aviv to eventually secure our visas. We were also only able to obtain the visas due to a situation that God had supernaturally set in order almost a year ago.

I know that God has us going to Nigeria for a reason and we look forward to everything He will impart to us. Please lift us up in your prayers as we are very excited to see what the Lord is going to do in Africa!

A Garden Grows!

Here at the house, we have been installing a beautiful garden over this last week. My mother, Pam, set this project in motion when she and Dad came for Elijah's birth. Amber and Lily have seen it through and we now have most of the seven species living on our balcony. I know one of

the things Amber has missed the most about being in Texas is not being able to spend time helping with the Israel Prayer Garden. I like to think of our garden here in Jerusalem as a little connection to home.
