I started out last week with a peculiar dream. Often when I have dreams, the Lord leads me to meditate on them for a period of time before releasing them publicly. In the case of this dream, the Lord immediately placed it on my heart to share the dream with others for intercession purposes. One of the things God has been teaching me lately is that this is a time to know how to hear His voice and act decisively. It is also a time that we are going to be able to see with clarity and call situations what they are so that the Lord can show us how to intercede and move forward.

In the dream, I was staying in a small town located on Israel's southeastern border with Jordan. One of the two younger couples who were staying with me was new in town and did not know their way around. I offered to take my new friend's wife to the Post Office and show her how to conduct business. After finishing at the Post Office, we walked out the front door, and were surprised to find a large round hole in front of the building. The hole was built up with dirt on all sides and had several IDF soldiers in it who were firing their rifles out into the desert. I turned to my friend's wife and told her it was very strange that the military would have built a firing range in the middle of the city. As we looked closer, I realized there were enemy soldiers in the desert shooting back at us.

Over the course of a few minutes the enemy troops had advanced from every direction and were closing in on our position. The fighting became so intense that our soldiers could barely keep their guns loaded fast enough to keep the enemy at bay. By that time, I was separated from my friend's wife and could not reach her. I had to make the decision to retreat from the battle field

and return to our house in the city. Just as I began to work my way through the city, a grenade exploded at my feet and lightly injured my leg.

When I arrived at the house, I met with the girl's husband who was a political analyst in the dream. I explained to him what had happened and that we could not go back for his wife until the fighting subsided. I made the comment that we needed to turn on the news and find out what had caused the battle. He then turned to me and said that Israel had done something to Jordan and Jordan was retaliating. I asked why Israel would have done anything to Jordan, as they are currently the most peaceful nation bordering Israel. He told me he was not surprised Israel had dealt with Jordan given their nuclear past. After this conversation, we began to make preparations to go back to the battlefield and get the man's wife.

In the natural this dream did not make much sense to me because Jordan is not known to have nuclear arms or capability. As I began to seek the Lord over the meaning of this dream he showed me two things. The first was that the mention of nuclear involvement with Jordan represents something hidden, whether it's something physical or a hidden spiritual alignment. The second thing was that the hole the soldiers were fighting in represents Israel's borders. The Lord showed me that just as the enemy advanced from all directions in the dream, we must keep watch in all directions. **This is a time to watch Jordan.**

After sharing this dream with some of the intercessors at the Global Spheres Center, I spoke with Pastor Joe Knight. Joe had just received a powerful word that morning in which the Lord showed him a picture of Amber and me inside a Post Office. The Lord showed him how he was taking us from one post box and filing us in a new one in order to keep us out of harm's way. I found this word very interesting as my dream the night before started in a Post Office that fit the description of the one Pastor Joe saw us in.

Amber:

The Lord is calling us into different locations where we believe this dream and Pastor Joe's word will be significant for our protection. We believe that every place that we enter will be filled

with a pocket of grace and we will have to move keenly in His perfect timing to stay under his wing. As Daniel and I discussed this dream together I immediately opened my Bible to Joshua chapter 1. This portion of the Bible talks about the promised borders of Israel and the strategies that the Lord gave to Joshua and the Israelites as they were crossing the Jordan River in order to take back the Land. The instruction that the Lord was giving them didn't make sense if they were to rationalize it. They had to trust and obey. **This is a season where the tides can turn at any moment, but as long as we are willing to simply trust and obey God we will have success.**

Be strong and very courageous. Be careful to obey all the law my servant Moses gave you; do not turn from it to the right or to the left, that you may be successful wherever you go. Keep this book of the Law always on your lips; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful. Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go. (Joshua 1:1-7)

The Lord is saying that He will make us prosperous and successful without regard to world circumstances if we will trust and obey!

We've had an incredible month here in the States. The Head of the Year gathering was incredible and we were so blessed to attend. We celebrated Daniel's 31st birthday for a week. We also had a huge family party on the last day of the Feast, which was also Daniel's actual birthday. While we were here Daniel was able to finish the photo book of our journey around Israel. This book will be available for all of you to purchase before the holidays. The book is called ***Out of Abraham***. We are excited to be returning to Israel to be part of God's plan there. We will land in Israel on Wednesday and begin classes at Ben Gurion University on the following Sunday.
