The discussion questions include:

- 1. Sinestro tells Hal that he dishonors the ring and its previous owner by wearing it. Yet Tomar-Re (the fish-headed GL) says that the ring never makes mistakes. Who do you think is right? Can they both be right?
- 2. Which character(s) in The Green Lantern do you most look up to? Why?
- 3. If an institution like the Green Lantern Corps really existed and included members of races all over the universe devoted to protecting the common good, what would that say about good and evil?
- 4. What is a hero? Can a single heroic act make someone a hero? Or is more required? Is Hal Jordan a hero? If so, when—and why—does he become a hero? Is his heroism convincing? Why or why not? Carol Ferris tells Hal that she sees something special in him. What does she see?
