We've taken a few short excursions out of Jaffa and Daniel is still learning his way around. He drove to Jerusalem twice and we took a day trip to Caesarea. We spent most of our time in the car this time but next time it should be easier for us to find our way. Caesarea is where much of the book of Acts occurred.




Since we have returned much has happened here that could determine the position that Israel takes to defend herself. Several rockets from Gaza have been fired -- one killing a man just less than an hour from where we live. We hear helicopters often. We've noticed that when the sky is busy, if you check the news you'll find that something is going on. Daniel, Lily and I are heading out on a prayer journey for the southern part of Israel on Sunday. We will drive through Beer Sheva all the way through to the closest border of Egypt that we can get to. Please pray that the Lord gives us the right strategy.

Since we have returned the city is so busy with construction. New buildings and remodeling! When we first came to look at apartments here the realtor kept telling us that this part of town was in revival. Since I think pretty spiritually and we were very jet lagged, I kept thinking that he was talking about spiritual revival. Of course he didn't mean that but since we've come back and see all of the changes we do feel like this is a place where spiritual revival will occur again!



Amber and I have been very busy over the last couple of weeks. I made several trips to Jerusalem to meet with our lawyer and finalize the visa process. Earlier this I received the final stamp from the government that will allow us to stay in the country for a full year. This was a very exciting day in our lives and we have much to be thankful for.

After seeking the Lord for our next step we believe He has called us to the border regions of Israel to intercede for this country and the fulfillment of promises over the land and relationships with neighboring regions. Amber and I plan to travel to these areas over the next month and will be sending out prayer focus points as the Lord leads us. We will also be reconnecting with some of our friends in the body of Christ as we go. Please pray for the safety of my family and that the Lord will guide our steps and continue to establish us here in Israel.

Israel is still in a place of very critical decisions. The Palestinian Authority continues to deal with the United Nations in an attempt to gain a unilateral declaration of statehood. Over the last week there have also been rumors in the media of a possible military strike against Iran's nuclear program. It is still unknown if the rumors are based in fact but the political fallout has already started. The issues of how to deal with rocket fire from Gaza are also still in the works. IDF forces tested a missile system and conducted a large scale training exercise in Italy over this last week. Please take some quiet time to lift up the leaders in Israel and pray that the Lord will

provide supernatural wisdom concerning these issues. Pray also that the Lord will bring to light all plans the enemy has set forth against his people.

As I read Acts 2:25-28, the Lord had me decree this verse over Israel: *“I saw the Lord always before me. Because he is at my right hand, I will not be shaken. Therefore my heart is glad and my tongue rejoices; my body also will live in hope, because you will not abandon me to the grave, nor will you let your holy one see decay. You have made known to me the paths of life; you will fill me with joy in your presence.”*
