everyday. She loves when we light the Hanukkah and loves receiving a Hanukkah gift everyday. Its really fun celebrating both holidays together. I think they call it Chrismukkah.



December 18th is our eight year wedding anniversary. We've been reminiscing on our time together for the past week. We were fairly young when we married and consider ourselves to have come a long way. Daniel was only 22 and I was 24. We knew each other for all of 3 months when we were engaged and 6 months by the time we married. It has been an adventure and we are so blessed. I'm often surprised at how good God has been to us. We have grown up a lot together since we first met. A few days ago we went to Jerusalem to spend time with Martin and Norma Sarvis. Daniel and I went out and bought matching right hand rings that say, "I am my beloveds and He is mine" in Hebrew to commence our eight years together.
