Dear Friends:

I love how the Lord directs our steps and moves us forward in His timing. Today, ***Daniel and Amber Pierce*** (and their daughter, Lily) are flying into Israel. (I just got a note that they were in Paris for their layover.) When Daniel was three months old, I looked at him in his crib, and the Lord told me that he would be sent to the nations. Last October when he came to me after serving for 7 years in law enforcement and told me that it was time for he and his family to shift, I knew it was the Lord.

I am excited to say that they are a Firstfruits that we are sowing in God's covenant land! *They will be living in Haifa.* For several years now, Amber has been developing the new oils and candles with her business, New Wine Lights. ***Now the Lord is calling Daniel and Amber to connect with the people and land of Israel in a new way, and will begin working to develop new products and relationships that are more closely related to the land.***

Please pray for their safety in travel and for their adjustment to living in a foreign land. They already have an apartment, but will need to furnish it before they can move in. Then they will begin learning about the land and how they can serve the people there. Below is Daniel's report from when they went to "scout the land" in January to get prepared for their move.

On 01/04/2011, Amber, Lindy Heidler, and I left for an eight day trip to Israel. Upon leaving DFW airport, the three of us had a very structured plan for our trip. Prior to leaving, Apostle Chuck had given a word over this trip about letting God restructure our steps on a continual basis. Dad could not have heard the Lord more clearly, as our plans changed daily throughout the trip.

A SIGN--Drought Breaks and Rain Comes! I would like to start by saying this was by far the most difficult trip I have ever been on and I have a new found respect for Apostle Chuck. Walking with the Lord and watching Him restructure our schedule was a wonderful experience. Before we left I spoke briefly on Sunday morning about the ongoing drought in Israel and asked

the congregation and webcasters to pray for rain. Israel, which was in drought, experienced rain almost every day. We watched as God paved the way for appointment after appointment.

A key apostolic leader and new friend, Avi Mizrachi, picked us up at the Tel Aviv airport. Avi is a respected Messianic leader in the community. He became very instrumental in our lives over the next few days. We settled into the Gilgal Hotel in Tel Aviv which is owned and operated by Christians. The next morning we got up and began to meet people and build relationships as planned. We met Avi in his office for a staff prayer meeting first thing that morning. The day's plans included looking at apartments in the Tel Aviv.

The Miracle Apartment! After looking at several apartments, Amber and I became discouraged as we had not seen any that would fit our needs with the baby. We quickly realized that real estate in Tel Aviv and Israel in general is not what we are used to here in the states. Please understand, I am not talking about a mansion, but just a place for a washer and dryer and room for a guest. Late that evening, Tsachi, one of Avi's staff members, took us to a real estate office on Ben Yehuda Street in downtown Tel Aviv. Inside we met with a realtor named Shay Ben Nun. We found that Shay had an apartment listed that was in our price range and appeared to fit our needs. The apartment was in a new building located on the border of Jaffa and Tel Aviv. Shay advised this apartment would go very quickly as it was new, priced well, and the last one in the building. The city of Tel Aviv was built up around Jaffa, which is a historical sea port.

We had not come to Israel fully prepared to make this commitment as our original plan for this trip was just to get a feel for real estate in the area. While discussing the listing, Shay explained he had plans for the next morning (Friday) and could not show us the apartment. We had plans for Shabbat (Saturday) and commitments in Jerusalem that needed to be honored. The next time we could have set an appointment would have been Monday or Tuesday nearing the end of our trip. Amber and I went back to our hotel room discouraged. As we began to discuss the events of that first day in Tel Aviv, we both began to discern the assignment of the enemy over that region. The feeling we had in that moment can be described as a crushing loss of vision. Tel Aviv is known for being very secular and the enemy's strategy there is tangibly different from other parts of the country.

Late that evening, Lindy got a call from Shay who had changed his plans and wanted to show us the apartment first thing Friday morning. Shay's phone call marked the beginning of us watching God realign our plans for the trip. First thing the next morning we followed Shay to the apartment. Amber and I quickly agreed the apartment was everything we were looking for and more. After the viewing I gave Shay a small fee to hold the apartment until I could speak to Apostle back home and seek guidance on how to move forward. Amber and I began to regain vision in seeing the Lord order our steps.

Friday evening, the three of us were invited to Avi's home in the west bank for Shabbat dinner. This invitation is a great honor in Israel. Avi stopped the car at a lookout point near his home. The lookout faced West and you could see the Tel Aviv sky line in the distance. Avi said something that really stuck with me. ***"The area between the lookout point and Tel Aviv represents over sixty percent of the population of Israel. The area we are looking at represents the harvest in Israel."***

When we arrived at Avi's home there was a feast waiting for us. Avi and his wife gave the Shabbat blessing and we began to eat. Avi's father, who immigrated and is a veteran of the 1948 war to free Israel, was also with us. We had a wonderful time and learned much about the history of Israel.

By early Saturday, Dad had responded that we were to move forward with the apartment. We attended a Torah reading and Shabbat service with Avi's congregation. That morning the Lord began to give Amber and me a vision of how we fit into His plan for the future. Saturday night, Lindy and I had a meeting in which the Lord totally restructured our schedule. All three of us felt the Lord had told us to cancel some of our plans and go to Jerusalem first thing Sunday. At that time, we did not know how we were going to finance the apartment as a wire transfer would take too long.

By Sunday morning the Lord reminded Lindy of a connection in Jerusalem who could get an American check cashed. We watched the Lord from that point forward provide all the resources to secure the apartment. *All the connections and resources the Lord provided made it possible to accomplish in four days what usually takes a month in Israel.* We have been very blessed by Martin and Norma Sarvis, Avi and family, Apostle Chuck, and Lindy Heidler.

We look forward to watching the Lord order our steps for the future and lead Glory of Zion into Israel in a whole new way.

We are going to:

1. *Look at the Harvest in Israel on a daily basis.*
2. *Prepare a place for others to come and become ONE with the Harvest that Jesus longed to see when He walked in the earth.*
3. *Connect with key places and individuals so that we can be a conduit for business between Israel and God's people throughout the world.*
4. *Learn the land that we have covenant with, so that the roots of faith continue into the next generation.*

Just under two weeks ago, Ray Hughes was part of the team that sent us forth from Glory of Zion. He said the word **Lily** (which is our daughter's name) means *trumpet*. We want to see our daughter become a trumpet for the next generation. Please pray for us as we advance this hour in a world that is very chaotic and into a region that is volatile.



Two Great Resources to Help you Align with your Covenant Roots


[Over the Dead of the Desert: Releasing Waters for Zion](#) by *Martin Sarvis*
