God meant for us to celebrate Rosh Chodesh each month. For the first four hundred (400) years of the early Church, they would gather at Firstfruits to give their best to the Lord, and then prophecy, healings, and miracles would occur. Shevat is the month associated with the Tribe of Asher. This is a time to unlock the fruitfulness of our "land" and the boundaries the Lord has given us to possess. 11 Days till the Best Portion of Your Life!

As I shared on Sunday morning during our Firstfruits Celebration, the Lord had been speaking to me from Deuteronomy 1:2, *"It is eleven days' journey from Horeb by way of Mount Seir to Kadesh Barnea. Now it came to pass in the fortieth year, in the eleventh month, on the first day of the month, that Moses spoke to the children of Israel according to all that the LORD had given him as commandments to them ..."* I believe this is a rhema word for each of us in this eleventh month (the month of Shevat). The Lord is saying starting today, if you call today, "Today", then within 11 days you can be in a new place! I believe that you will be at a new place the moment you say, "I am beginning today!" In Hebrews 3:12-4:1-10 we find the same principle as in Deuteronomy. In Deuteronomy 1:6, the Lord said through Moses, *"You have dwelt long enough at this mountain. Turn and take your journey..."* **I believe each of us can choose to stop going around the mountain again and again and again, and instead, can take these next 11 days to go up and possess the promise awaiting us. This is your day to determine that you are willing to go into your new,**

and to see your blessings manifest before you. You have to decree that you are going to face off any resistant circumstance and go in to lay hold of your blessings. *Today can be called today --- the first day of the best portion of your life! You choose!!!* As a people, we must make a choice if we are willing to journey to a new place in 11 days, or if we want to instead wait 40 years to come to our place of promise.

Here are some action points for the 11 days: *Know your destination – where are you trying to go? What rights has God given you to the boundaries where you are headed? What is your assignment to accomplish? Have you stopped and allowed the Lord’s Spirit to sanctify you in a new way? Have you gained strategy to move past the last invincible mountain in your last season? Have you removed the old reproach from the past season? Have you gained a glimpse of your new identity? Have you decreed that you want the inheritance that the Lord has for you? Do you have faith that you can come from behind and overtake what the enemy has set against you -- even the losses from last season?*

During this eleven day period we will continue to gather on weekdays for 5:15 Movement. We started TODAY! All of you are welcome to join us tomorrow (Thursday), Friday, Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday for 5:15 Movement to help us pivot and press into the right direction during this eleven days.

Remove the Crutch!

Keith Pierce did a miracle act on Sunday during the service. He said, “Chuck, get out of the way! The crutch is leaving!” I heard the Lord speak this to me!

Susan Stanfield, one of our key staff members who has assisted me for years, had struggled greatly over the last two years with her hip, and had been using a cane. However, Keith called the cane a crutch and declared the crutch would not go into the next season. I asked Susan what she was seeing as she pressed forward and walked cautiously into the office on Monday. Here was her reply:

After Keith threw my cane, then once again, when it didn’t get as far as he’d hoped, on the first throw, and walked away, I said to Pam, “**Now what do I do?**” Penny immediately sent Robert, to escort me back to my chair. I remember sitting there, thinking, “**What now?**” But, Penny had sent Robert and John to escort me to my car. As I recall, I didn’t make use of their arms. They just walked with me, in case I needed assistance. On the way to Chuy’s, I said, “**Lord, what is going on?**” He immediately reminded me of when Jesus prayed for the blind man, then asked what he saw, and he said, “**I see men, like trees, walking.**” So, that’s the verse I had to remind myself of for most of the first day. I had even forgotten it, until writing this for you. At this stage, I am in the “**seeing men, like trees, walking**” part of this new walk.

At home, I heard myself getting winded, just walking around, and thought, “**Good grief. What has the cane done to me?**” (I’ve lately asked the Lord what to do, since the pressure on the left side of my body – wrist, elbow, shoulder, neck – was causing great pain.) I can tell you my neck is tons better, already, and I’m hoping for a turn-around for the wrist and elbow. Whenever the thought came, “**You’re going to be in a mess, without a cane,**” I’d have to push that thought aside, and just keep on walking. Both yesterday and today, Lisa Lyons shared what the Lord has shown her about Jesus cursing the fig tree, and we can do the same if we have faith and don’t doubt. I said to the Lord, “**So ‘doubt’ would be when I try to reason my way through this?**”, and He reminded me of the new song He gave me to sing, several months ago:

*I’m gonna stop trying to figure this out,
I’m gonna stop trying to figure this out.
You are the Way, and You have the means
I’m gonna stop trying to figure this out.*

Therefore, I am to keep walking, and not try to figure this out.
