Wednesday, March 14, 2012

We wanted to send you an update following yesterday's letter. The unrest in southern Israel was ongoing throughout Sunday night and today. After a day full of sirens we were again awakened at 3:30 AM this morning. We quickly piled into the bomb shelter along with Lily and our house guests. After hearing the rockets explode, we left the shelter and went back to bed. Approximately five minutes later the siren sounded again. We all met back in the shelter for the second time in ten minutes. The alarms sounded for the third time around 9:30 AM. At least we were out of bed by then!

The whole family and our guests attended a worship meeting today with Avner and Rachel Boskey. This is just what the family needed. Taking the time to meet with the Holy Spirit in times of stress and war is what sustains us. During worship we felt as if the Lord was expressing to us to be a joy and encouragement everywhere we go. We spent time in town and ate lunch together with our friends in Be'er Sheva. Everyone in the restaurant seemed tense and unhappy, but the Lord had spoken to us to be joyful! As soon as we got to the restaurant and sat down, the alarms started to sound again. The whole restaurant ran for cover in the kitchen as it was the safest room in the building. While waiting for the explosion, Daniel pulled out his phone and started taking pictures of all the people crammed in the small room. Everyone around us started to laugh and take pictures as well. That seemed to turn the mood. People began to smile and visit with each other. This was an example of how we can see our atmosphere change when we walk in Joy.

Out and about spreading joy in the midst of war! Our friends Tsachi and Angie came to stay a few days with us even though we're running in and out of the bomb shelter! As soon as we sat down to lunch the whole restaurant ran for the bomb shelter as the sirens began to sound
