Earlier this week, Daniel, Lily and I had the pleasure of visiting Martin and Norma Sarvis in Jerusalem. This was our first excursion since our move six weeks ago. It was such a blessing to see them and Jerusalem. They are doing well. They are key communicators of events here and how to pray "in the land."

**ALL of Creation Sounds!** Daniel and I have been to Israel four other times but we have never been able to see the mountains in all of their splendor, in spring time. Everything is green and blooming now. As we drove away from Jerusalem to return back to our home in Jaffa it was as if all of nature was rejoicing. Norma commented that even the birds were singing differently. As we headed out through the mountains and I kept hearing Isaiah 55:12: "*For you will go out with joy and be led forth with peace; the mountains and the hills will break forth into shouts of joy before you, and all the trees of the field will clap their hands. Instead of the nettle the myrtle will come up, and it will be a memorial to the Lord, for an everlasting sign which will not be cut off.*" The city has built a large bridge with "strings" connected atop it formed into a giant harp. Of course it reminds me of David and the way that he began everyday with worship. I'm not sure if the architects who built this wonderful bridge/harp realized that they were building a memorial to the Lord. What a wonderful way to enter a city with a call to the heart of worship. This is a sign that worship to the God of Israel is being restored.

**Miracles This Month!** This is my favorite month! Lily and I were both born in the month of April. My birthday is April 21<sup>st</sup> just as my grandfather Ray Gross was also born April 21<sup>st</sup>. This is the grandfather who told Daniel and me that we were actually Jewish shortly after we were married. Some of you remember my struggles in getting pregnant with Lily, but few know that I actually only had a 2% chance of the possibility of conceiving, BUT GOD! I will never ever forget the morning that I woke up with a positive pregnancy test. For a person who has had a few years of negative tests, you have to understand that I actually thought I was hallucinating at the results. A few hours later, after the excitement settled enough that I could think again, I did the math and realized that my due date for Lily was in fact, April 21, my and my grandfather's

birthday. The doctor confirmed this date without my ever having said a word. I knew God must be restoring something from my bloodline to Daniel and me.

I also know that God had so perfectly ordained the very perfect time for *Lily* to live. I just wanted a baby, any baby, I didn't care what baby. I didn't realize that it's a supernaturally connected thing like getting saved, or married, or receiving the next new assignment that God has for your life. It's the perfect connection of time and destiny.

This is true for the rest of our lives ... by faith we have to let God order our steps otherwise we're just wasting time. I wasted a lot of time trying to get pregnant because I did most of it without faith. The Lord spoke to me how I must "*seek first the kingdom and then all of these things will be added to you.*"

This testimony is just an example of taking your hands off of anything that you really want so that God can work in it. It's such a blessing to see Lily, who is a picture of resurrection to us, and then to see the Lord bring her all the way around the world to Israel. We felt as if we were bringing our first fruit to the Lord when we took Lily to Jerusalem for the first time.

We are so honored and blessed and excited to be here but at the same time the one thing I wanted for my birthday is to be with all of you at the Passover Celebration on April 21-24. Glory of Zion is so amazing and that gathering is going to be outstanding! Daniel, Lily and I are honored to have Passover in a few weeks in Jerusalem with Martin and Norma. And of course, we will be webcasting the gathering in Denton!




### **New Wine Lights**

We are so excited to watch **The Oil of Triumph** form. This is our first anointing oil to formulate while living in the Land so of course that takes a team. We have Daniel and me over here, and Cyndi Moody who is a full time employee of New Wine Lights running our business in

Denton. She is a blessing to us! Cyndi has worked closely with Apostle Chuck and Daniel and me, and with the help of technology, has helped produced this new oil from the GZI team.

The oil has an interesting testimony! When Chuck asked me to produce something out of Israel, I knew just what I wanted to do. The **Jaffa** port is the oldest in Israel and one of the oldest in the world. The main element shipped through this port was **Cedar of Lebanon** which was used to build the temples. Instantly I knew this should be an element in the oil. Then Chuck told me to add **orange**. By faith I said yes, even though I didn't see the significance. I didn't worry much because I trust him. A few days later Daniel begins to tell me that he noticed orange trees all around Jaffa. I said, "Are you kidding? Your dad told me to put orange in the new oil and I didn't see the significance!"



The next day I began to tell a friend this little story. He said, "I have a book called **Jaffa the City of Oranges**." This city is known for its oranges and I didn't even know it. The book says that from about where my new apartment stands to the beach used to be nothing but fields of oranges. You could actually smell them in the air. Wouldn't that be wonderful? This oil also has almond in it, and goodness, the almond blossoms here are of course, beautiful.

*What makes Jaffa a little different than other places in Israel (and the purpose of the book) is to tell the story of how Jews and Arabs have managed to live here together.*

During Passover we celebrate Israel's deliverance out of Egypt. As believers we celebrate the sacrifice that God gave the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, and that Jesus triumphed over the power of death and darkness and actually was resurrected from the dead. We have an amazing testimony as believers. What's really awesome about our God is that He wants us operating in the earth as He did. This is displayed in Acts 9:36. In Biblical times Peter actually came to Jaffa (back then they called it Joppa). He prayed for Tabitha to be resurrected from the dead and she was. Because of this miracle all of Jaffa believed in the Lord! We live one block

from where this happened. Some of you remember our testimony last week of Isaac the plumber. Before we left the United States, Apostle Chuck ordained Daniel and me, so pray that as we serve that the disciples would be many and that signs and wonders would follow here. Pray that many would begin to believe just as they did in the book of Acts!
