



## ***A New Garden: Fire By Night and Cloud by Day!*** ***(from Pam Pierce)***



*Dear Pursuing Saints:*

I want to thank each of you for your dedicated giving to the Israel Prayer Garden. Because of you, we have added the vineyard and the winepress. We've been able to replant the garden for summer. We have also extended the borders of the Garden. I believe this is spiritual. God's will was for His people to take the Garden He planted for them and move that glory throughout the whole earth. I am so excited about you coming and visiting us this summer.

On Tuesday evening we dedicated an exciting new area of our Garden ... **Fire by Night and Cloud by Day!** Pam shares below how she was led to develop this new feature, and all of you will want to visit it the next time you are here. The basis of the *Fire by Night and Cloud by Day Garden* comes from Exodus 13:21: "*By day the Lord went ahead of them in a pillar of cloud to guide them on their way and by night in a pillar of fire to give them light, so that they could travel by day or night.*"

Pam shares:

“Sometimes, while working in the garden, the Lord drops a thought or image into my heart. Often, His purpose is a personal word of encouragement or a reminder of His presence. But many times, as I walk through the garden with an eye toward the future, the Father clarifies my vision for this small piece of earth in Corinth, Texas.

“Late last winter, I began to hear the Lord say that He is our fire by night and cloud by day, committed to guiding us through wilderness places until we see our Promised Land. I knew then that the garden needed a physical representation of that concept and began planning a new vignette for the space between the community garden and the Israel Prayer Garden.

“On Friday, May 24, we installed a Tempest Torch surrounded by plants that will represent fire and cloud. The plants that will represent the cloud by day are a Grace variety of smoke tree, compact Texas sage, and ornamental grasses that will produce feathery white and pink seed heads in late summer. Other than the flame of the Tempest Torch, the garden also contains red yucca, firebush, and red shrimp plant.

“This week, we dedicated the new Fire by Night and Cloud by Day garden. With a statue of Moses in the foreground, we lit the Tempest Torch for the first time. This garden, for me, is a reminder of God’s commitment to my future regardless of the time of day! *Whether the sun is obscured by clouds or night, I know that my Father is leading me through any and every wilderness.*”
