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*“He stays the same through the ages, there may be pain in the night but joy comes in the morning”.*

The past season has been extremely trying for all of us! All of the difficulty and uncertainty is producing great strength for our future. I don't know anyone who hasn't felt a little shake as try to walk and take new ground. However, I know more than we can imagine is on the other side. God has such big plans for us! Also, I know that we can't become what God created us to be if we don't have obstacles and challenges.

Sometimes, nothing feels as if it is happening and we each feel that we are not being used---you feel like you don't have a purpose or that you're not making an impact on anyone or anything. That is not true! Times when we have to wait, are the times when God is really developing our character.

There are a few things in my life that I thought at the time were the worst thing that could happen to me. Obviously the one that is the easiest to draw a biblical connection to is the Barren Woman. All through the Bible, God uses barren women to teach praising your way through circumstances. Even when things couldn't get any worse, you have nothing ... you're shamed, but you **STILL MUST PRAISE HIM**.

The call is very clear in Isaiah 54, "*Sing O barren woman!*" This is not just a call to women. Rather, this is how the Lord wants all of us to love Him. Trust Him even though you don't have what you want or what you think you need at the time.

Back when I couldn't get pregnant, I became very resentful and jealous. I couldn't look at children, and God forbid if someone else got pregnant. How embarrassing! I realized that people had to be nervous to tell me they were pregnant. I will just never forget when John and Stephanie became pregnant with Chloe. Of course I loved them and Chloe is amazing, but I felt that God had betrayed me. I had been begging God for a baby for years and they, all the sudden, got pregnant a month after their honeymoon. I really believed for a few days that God had done something wrong to me. I felt like God didn't love me as much. I felt like He was just passing out babies and I was standing in line saying, "Pick me", but He just passed right over me. I really didn't know how I would manage to go on with my life. I know this might sound ridiculous, but I learned a lot from walking that out.

After the emotions of the situation settled, I decided to really lay my desire to have a child on the altar. God said to me, "*Seek first the kingdom!*" Then I made a decision. *I would serve and help in any area I could no matter what it was.* I had to stop focusing on what I thought I was supposed to have and really serve.

A few weeks after that, Chuck invited me to go a few places with his team. I served on the prophetic ministry team at a conference in Seattle and I was blown away by what God was doing in and around me. All during ministry time, people were asking me to pray for them to get pregnant. It seemed strange to me because I didn't feel anointed for that since I wasn't capable of getting pregnant. However, I served because I knew it was the Lord.

Several people who didn't know anything about me began to ask me to pray for them, and most of them had much worse situations than I. Some had been trying for 10 years to get pregnant. Some didn't even have ovaries. I prayed for people and really began to desire for each one of them to have what I couldn't.

At the very end of the conference a lady came to me and said, "*The Lord spoke to me for you. He says to sing over the barren places, and to read Isaiah 54.*" I am not a singer and really can't carry a tune very well---so even if it was just me and the Lord, this was very embarrassing for me to do. This woman's words laid very heavy on me and a few weeks went by before I decided to do what she had said.

One day when I was all alone driving, I decided to obey. I sounded awful and I was very emotional. *I started to sing over my barrenness.* One month later, I was pregnant!!!!!!!!!!!!

To really follow Christ and be what God created us to be, we have to pour everything out to Him. This walk we each have chosen, is a relationship of pouring out - not a religion of just taking in. *Our human nature says to take, but God intends for us to give.*

The key to healing and deliverance and your future is to pour out. Luke 7:37 says that a woman who lived a sinful life learned that Jesus was eating at a Pharisee's house. She brought an alabaster jar of perfume, and as she stood behind him at his feet weeping, she began to wet his feet with her tears. Then she wiped them with her hair, kissed them and poured perfume on them. I tear up every time I read this scripture. Her heart to pour out of herself was what unlocked her future. She wasn't asking for anything -- she just wanted to pour out everything she had. I want to encourage you to meditate on this scripture.

Daniel, Lily and I are in Louisiana now to visit family before our return to Israel. We are enjoying the opportunities that God has given us as we believe for the doors to open for us to return to our home in Israel.

We will have the privilege of attending the ***Open Doors Conference*** in the new Global Spheres Center on July 29-31.
