Tuesday, July 24

I spent this last week at the Bondage to Freedom Youth Camp in the Zin desert.

Of the fifty kids that attended the camp most of them had an incredible experience with the Lord. At the beginning of camp some of the youth told their counselors they had come to have fun and did not care about learning the Torah. Over the next two days the camp staff and several intercessors continued to press into the Spirit for breakthrough. Some of the youth from Beer Sheva were leading worship on the morning of the third day when the Holy Spirit fell heavily in the room. All of the kids joined into worship with flags and began to open their hearts before the Lord.



After the worship session one of the counselors, who was my roommate, spoke an incredible message about the wrath of God and how Jesus redeemed our sins. He spoke the message from the standpoint of Samuel as if he had personally witnessed several Biblical events. The message was presented in a new and innovative way that really held the attention of both the youth and the adults in the room. After the message, most of the kids went to the front of the room to meet with their counselors and receive prayer. Just being present to bear witness to this outpouring of the Holy Spirit was a life changing experience. Most of the counselors I spoke with had never seen the Lord move on the youth in such a strong way. That night another counselor shared his testimony of how God brought him out of a long struggle with alcoholism and drug abuse, and how he once lived in an abandoned hotel. After the testimony, all of the kids rushed to the front of the room and surrounded the speaker to pray for him.

The time at camp was a lot of fun to spite temperatures over a hundred degrees almost every day. Not all of the air conditioners in our cabins were working up to standard and the local pool was like a warm bath. Ste Boker where the camp took place is a small town way out in the desert that sits on the rim of a beautiful canyon.



This week has been the longest time I have been away from Amber and Lily since we moved to Israel last October. I missed them very much! Amber and Lily made a trip to Tel Aviv to meet with some close friends who just had a baby and attend the Brit, a party held in the home immediately after circumcision.



Our family returned to Tel Aviv Saturday morning to attend congregation. After the service, Avi and Chaya Mizrachi took us to one of their favorite restaurants and we had a wonderful time visiting about what the Lord is doing in our lives and in Israel and the Middle East.

For those of you who have been keeping up with the news, you are probably aware of the recent escalations in Syria. A bombing that occurred last week in Damascus killed several top government officials. The bombing has been seen internationally as possibly changing the sixteen-month-old uprising in favor of opposition forces who are trying to overthrow Assad. Israel's most immediate concern over the situation in Syria is the possible destabilization of large stockpiles of chemical weapons held by the Syrian military. If lost in the power shuffle, these weapons could end up in the hands of Hezbollah or other terrorist organizations. Israel has already stated it will not allow the transfer of chemical weapons to terrorist groups outside of Syria. As civilians, we are preparing our home for any possible outcome!

As always please continue to pray for the security of Israeli citizens and that God would continue to move in powerful ways.
