Most of Lily's friends live with in a few blocks.

Below are a few pictures of the new home. You'll notice the beautiful 800 year old olive tree and very old original stone work. Christian German Templars built this home. They sought to rebuild the Temple and built many homes in Jerusalem, and two key neighborhoods in Israel.



There is so much that we want to share with you about this home. We have slept here 6 nights and it's a wonderful family place. The kids are sleeping better and later. The day we moved in, Elijah turned 2 years old. He is very big and strong, and a daddy's boy all the way!
