Summer vacation has officially ended and our kids are once again adjusting to the routine of school. It seems like this summer came and went in a flash, as we stayed very busy. Ironically, when I stop and think about everything that happened over the last three months, it feels like years have passed! and felt the Lord leading us to go at the end of August. It turned out that the week we were out of town Israeli cities saw some of the heaviest rocket fire since the current round of fighting began. A long-term ceasefire went into effect the day before we returned. Our time in Cyprus was restful for the whole family and we thank God for providing. The kids enjoyed playing at the beach and swimming everyday. Lily spent early mornings catching fish, crabs and shrimp.

Again we saw ourselves in the footsteps of the Apostle Paul. We stayed very close to the first location that Paul and Barnabas docked on the Island of Cyprus before the dispute that they had over John Mark in the book of Acts. The Word says that from there Paul and Silas went to Paphos (the opposite side of the island) and the Spirit of God blessed them greatly. We are grateful to be able to travel to places of the Bible from Jerusalem. These experiences have been helpful as we study the Word.

We are now looking forward to the New Year and the Holidays to come in Israel. This is such a great time to be here. We are in a season when we allow God to search our hearts and when we will personally forgive debts of the past. As we do this we can move into the year ahead with fresh vision and renewed strength.
