As we return from Nigeria, I am walking away knowing that the Holy Spirit has moved in my life in ways I could not have imagined. If you read our last letter, I wrote briefly about how the Lord supernaturally laid our path straight for this trip. We went to Nigeria knowing that we were about to experience things that would change our perspective and bring new revelation to our future.

While at the conference, someone asked what I thought about Nigeria and the move of God that is taking place there. I feel like it is easy for outsiders to go to a place where there is much poverty and become overcome with emotion by what they see. I have been to several places now where people live with few of the comforts that we think of as necessities. But there is something very different about Nigeria. For a people and a nation that have many reasons to be defeated, instead these people have chosen to *walk in victory!*

You can feel the hunger for the truth on the streets and see the effects of the Holy Spirit in the community. While in Nigeria we stayed in the city of Kafanchan in Kaduna State. Throneroom Ministry and Apostle Emmanuel Kure have had a profound effect on the city of Kafanchan and its people. I remember how the Lord impressed on me that this situation is a picture of how God's Kingdom should look when the house of worship and spiritual leadership takes its place at the center of the community. Wherever the Holy Spirit is, you will see a new order set in the physical circumstances of the land!

Another thing someone said that really stuck with me was that the Holy Spirit never leaves a void. When governments rise and fall, power voids cause confusion and strife, but there is never a void left in the Holy Spirit! You can see this at work in Nigeria as God meets needs and sets an order, based on His will, for the people there!

On the first day we attended the conference, I was blessed to share some of our personal experiences and testimonies from living in Israel.

There are many in Nigeria who support Israel, so it was a real blessing to get connected and share what God is doing in our lives. Amber also prophesied out of a message God has been building in her for months, concerning the rivers of living waters.

Amber

I saw a river of people -- so many people that I couldn't even see water! That's because we are the river flowing from the temple (the church). Everywhere you go, you will give life to the dead places and the Dead Sea will be dead no longer, but rather filled with many fish! The Lord had given me a whole message on this that started with several dreams of rivers one year ago. That message was knit together while in Nigeria.



Our scheduled time in Kafanchan felt so short. This was our first international trip that would require us to leave our children at home in Israel, so we needed to see how things would go. When we found out that Apostle Kure had planned to use us in a greater way closer to the end of the conference, we began to question if we were in the right timing. After making some phone calls, we discovered that we would have to leave Nigeria as scheduled because our flight could not be changed.

When we arrived at the airport in Abuja, I met a Muslim girl in the airport lounge. I needed an I-Pad charger at the time and she offered to let me use hers. As soon as I sat down next to her I could feel the Holy Spirit start to hover over our conversation.

She explained that she had just married a man in Cairo about two months prior and was on the way to see him.

It wasn't long before the I-Pad came on and I began to show her pictures of our family and the trip to Nigeria. She began asking if Daniel was a pastor and if I also spoke in the church. God quickly began to open the door for me to share the love He has for her and the purpose He has over her life.

She broke into tears and I could tell she wanted to receive Jesus. Sometimes when you look at someone, you can see their heart has just been confronted with the truth. Although her world had just been turned upside down, she was still conflicted in her circumstances and how making a commitment to the Lord would fit into her recent life changes. As a Muslim, she could be killed for making this commitment. Before we parted ways, I told her that there would come a time when she would cry out to God and He would receive her. I gave her my information and told her to contact me when this happens and I would pray with her!

I know that God ordered our steps and caused our time that we felt had been lost in Kafanchan, to be reordered in Abujah. This girl had never heard the Gospel before, and I have never seen someone so overcome with emotion while telling them how much God loves them. Even though we felt our timing was wrong and that we had something greater to release at the conference, God's purpose was for us to release His Spirit to one individual! ***God is always reminding us to stop for the one!***
