This morning, I woke up excited about the upcoming Pentecost conference and all that the Lord has in store for us over the next several weeks. I started my quiet time in Acts chapter two which tells the story of Pentecost. As I read, the Lord started to impart to me a whole new understanding of God's will for us as a church and the future that goes with that.

Over the last couple of decades there have been many who have prophesied the return of Jesus or the Apocalypse on a specific date. My personal opinion has always been that we know not the time or the hour and should live accordingly from day to day. What is so exciting about the story of Pentecost is that it portrays a clear picture of God's will for believers both now and as we move forward into the future. For anyone who has never had a true experience with the Holy Spirit, this passage in Acts provides about as clear a picture as you will ever find.

As Peter stood with the other eleven a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from Heaven and filled the house. Soon after the men saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.

As you read through the New Testament, you will find that there is always a reason for signs, wonders, prophecy, and fruits of the Spirit. Miracles come out of faith and produce faith among believers and non-believers alike. This is what it means to understand a move of the Holy Spirit in the earth realm.

Let's look at what happens next in Acts chapter 2:5-13. *"Now there were staying in Jerusalem Jews from every nation under heaven. When they heard the sound, a crowd came together in bewilderment, because each one heard them speaking in his own language. Utterly amazed, they asked how is it that each of us hears them in his own native language."* The passage goes on to state that over three thousand of the people got saved that day.

Now in verse 14-21 Peter addresses the crowd at Pentecost and lays out a word spoken by the prophet Joel about what we can expect in the end times. *"In the last days, God says, I will pour out my spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophecy, your young men will see visions, and your old men will dream dreams. Even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out My spirit in those days and they will prophecy. I will show wonders in the heavens above and signs on the earth below, blood and fire and billows of smoke. The sun will be turned to darkness and the moon to blood before the great and glorious day of the Lord. And everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."*

So this is what we have to look forward to in the future as believers. Through the pouring out of the Holy Spirit we will see faith building signs and wonders, we will see many saved no matter what language they speak, and all who call on the name of the Messiah will be saved. Over these next two weeks pray that the Lord would bring our hearts to a new place of understanding and excitement over what Pentecost represents. Also pray that God's will for the church will be fulfilled and works of the spirit will be the result.

As you pray for Israel, pray that Jews of every nation and tongue would once again be reached supernaturally. Pray that Israel would have a real experience with the Holy Spirit and the sound of a violent wind from heaven would fill the land. As Israel is brought to the threshing floor in this trying season, pray that the chaff would be blown away and allow for a new move of the Holy Spirit.

Amber and I look forward to seeing all of you at the Pentecost conference next weekend in the Global Spheres Center building. Let the Lord lead you into a new and exciting time of communion with the Holy Spirit and come expecting miracles!
