Israel's war with Hamas continues to rage as we enter the seventh straight day of fighting. All major cities in Israel have experienced ongoing rocket fire as the military prepares to take further steps on Israel's behalf. Up to date, the city of Jerusalem has made four trips to the bomb shelter as other communities have been targeted almost around the clock.

As hostilities continue, many Israeli families experience increased hardship, especially in southern communities that typically get hit with the bulk of rocket fire. Yesterday, I made a trip to Be'er Sheva to meet with some old friends and help provide groceries and toys for some of these families. Children living in cities near Gaza often suffer traumatic effects from constant air raid sirens and trips to the shelter. One of the families we were able to provide for is a single mother with four children who has been living in a shelter since the conflict began. On Sunday, Glory of Zion International Ministries purchased groceries for four single parent families and toys for seven children living in the Be'er Sheva area. For me, it has been an honor to help out in this way. Please continue to pray for the families and children on both sides of the conflict that God would protect the innocent and bring restoration from all trauma caused by the war.
